Dog Walkers – Please Be Aware Of The Law!

With so many stories about dogs in the news recently it is worth reminding dog walkers of the law relating to walking your dogs especially in and around the village:

- You can legally walk up to 6 dogs together but it is your responsibility to ensure they get along and are kept under control.
- Where a lead is used, it must be a maximum of 2m in length (fixed or locked) Extendable leads are acceptable, but they should be locked at a length of 2m or less.
- If your dogs are off lead they MUST be under your full control and if you cannot guarantee their recall please keep them on a lead as if your dog, jumps up at someone or causes distress you can be prosecuted
- Dogs must be placed on a lead at the request of an authorised officer.
- Dog walkers must carry sufficient means to pick up their dog foul. (Remember waste can go in ANY bin it does not have to be a special dog waste bin).

If we all obey the rules, then it will be a happy and safe village for us and our dogs!
