The Rowton/Christleton A41 Pelican Crossing

Campaign Group is a group of residents who aim to petition Cheshire West & Chester Council (CWAC) to install a pelican crossing on the A41 in the vicinity of Rowton Bridge Road/Rowton Lane junction. We have made great progress this year and have really come together as a community to support this initiative. Together we have collected over 400 signatures via both our online petition (<http://tiny.cc/d6as6y>) and paper petition, please do sign if you haven't already! In September CWAC conducted a 12 hour survey which counted both the number of pedestrians crossing and the volume of traffic, for which we are awaiting the results. Currently we are obtaining letters of support from local businesses and organisations which together with the petitions, we will formally submit to CWAC early November for their review.
